### Brain conditions that can now be treated close to home:

#### Brain Trauma

**153** Number of people in the U.S. that die from traumatic brain injury every day

**30%** Percent of all injury deaths that result from traumatic brain injury

#### Stroke

Every **40** seconds someone in the U.S. has a stroke

**13%** of strokes that are hemorrhagic and may require surgical intervention

#### Brain Tumors

An estimated **700,000** Americans are living with a brain tumor

An estimated **78,980** people received a primary brain tumor diagnosis in 2018

In 2018, more than 100 neurosurgical procedures have been performed at Frye Regional Medical Center. 39% of these procedures would have left our community before the Frye Regional Brain Center was established.

Patients requiring neurosurgery receive needed medical care faster when they are treated close to home.



Patient families also benefit when neurosurgical care is available close to home. Convenient care may mean less time away from work and less commuting for a loved one's rehabilitation and support services.

### Frye Regional's Brain Center specialists available in our community:



**Neurosurgeons**—Perform surgeries related to brain injury and disease

**Neurologists**—Evaluate and treat brain and nervous system problems

**Psychiatrists**—Provide inpatient and outpatient care to treat mental health disorders

**Critical Care**—Treat complex conditions associated with brain injury and illness

**Neuroradiologists**—Use medical imaging techniques to diagnose brain illnesses and diseases

**Physical Medicine and Rehabilitation**—Rehabilitate patients who have suffered a brain illness or injury

**Sports Medicine**—Evaluate and treat concussions
